## About the School

Army Public School, Jorhat (APSJ) was established on 01 July 1992 with thirteen students, three teachers and three administrative staff. The School is run under the overall aegis of Army Welfare Education Society (AWES) and is under the administrative control of GOC, 41 Sub Area. It is a co-educational institution having classes from I to XII. The Primary wing is located at Saraibari Military Station and the Senior wing at MES Gate, Rowriah, Jorhat.

# Admission Procedure

Academic Session begins in the 1st week of April every year. Priority is given to children of serving Army personnel, Army war widows, etc.

Admission tests are conducted in the last week of March for admission to various classes for the new session.

Application form, duly completed should be submitted to the school office on or before the prescribed date. Late submission of application form will not be entertained.

Admission is given to children of serving Army personnel coming on transfer from outstation at any time during the academic session. Children of Army Ex-Servicemen, Air Force / Navy (serving and retired) and children of Civilians paid out of Defence Estimates are also eligible for admission. Depending on availability, up to a maximum of 20% seats are given to civilian children. Merit is the main criterion for admission of civilian children. Admission tests will be conducted, wherever it is applicable, as per AWES rules. For admission to class I, a student should have completed 5 years of age on 31 March of the year in which admission is sought.

- Photocopy of Part II Order/ Birth Certificate signed by the CO/OC unit
- Countersigned TC
- Report Card of previous class
- Serving certificate of father

### Ex Servicemen

- Countersigned TC
- Report card of previous class
- Photocopy of Discharge Book

### TC from other School

The District Education Officer of the district in which the school is located shall endorse TC in respect of candidates coming from schools other than APS/KVs. The endorsement should clearly indicate whether it is a recognised school.

### Admission to Class XI

The minimum percentages/ grades for allocation of different streams for Class XI for Army Students are given below. However admission will depend on relative merit and availability of seats.

1. For allotment of streams the overall result will be considered.
2. The CBSE policy on Maths and Basic Maths shall also be taken into account while allocating streams.
