ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- Academic Session begins in the 1st week of April every year.
- First priority is given to the wards of serving Army personnel including DSC(Ex-Army), wards of Army widows and wards of those TA personnel who have a minimum of 5 years embodied service.

ENTRANCE TEST

- Admission tests will be conducted, wherever it is applicable, as per AWES rules .
- Admission tests are conducted in the last week of March for admission to various classes for the new session.
- Application form, duly completed should be submitted to the school office on or before the prescribed date .
- Late submission of application form will not be entertained .

Admission is given to wards of serving Army personnel coming on transfer from outstation at any time during the academic session. Wards of TA, DSC (Army), Ex- Serviceman(Army) are also eligible for admission. Depending on availability, up to a maximum of 20% seats are given to civilian children. Merit is the main criterion for admission of civilian children. For admission to class I, a student should have completed 6 years of age on 31 March of the academic year in which admission is sought.

- Report Card of previous class
- Photocopy of Discharge Book

TC FROM OTHER SCHOOL

- The District Education Officer of the district in which the school is located shall endorse TC in respect of candidates coming from schools other than APS/KVs. The endorsement should clearly indicate whether it is a recognized school.

- The CBSE policy on Standard Mathematics/ Basic Mathematics shall also be taken into account while allocating streams.
